Definition

A **mullion** is a vertical or horizontal **element** that forms a division between units of a window or screen, or is used decoratively.^[1] When dividing adjacent **window** units its primary purpose is a rigid support to the glazing of the window. Its secondary purpose is to provide structural support to an arch or **lintel** above the window opening.
